LAB bicycle commuting instruction – John Thomas has arranged for this in Lafayette.
National budget cutting has potentially endangered US DOT funding in 2012 and future years for bicycle and pedestrian projects.

- a. UZO (Unified Zoning Ordinance) may change to add a new High Density category to be used for WL Village development. We have been asked by the WL City Engineer to provide guidance for him about bicycle parking in this area to be provided by the new businesses.
- b. CLEAN city challenge: Survey of city employees about commuting mode, perceived obstacles to using alternative modes, and potential impact of incentives.
- c. Revised Bike-ped plan (old plan is [here](#)) and plans for state roads that will revert to city ownership soon
- d. Bike to work day was held Friday May 20, 2011 – Discussion and feedback
- e. Web site development: www.westlafayettebikeped.org – hosting server move
- f. Snow removal from sidewalks
- g. Possible new projects: Bicycle route maps and bicycle parking at businesses
