There were presentations by Mike Spencer from Tippecanoe County Highway Department on the Klondike Lindberg project west of US231/US52 and by David Buck from West Lafayette on the plans for reconstruction of Lindberg Rd between Salisbury and Northwestern Ave. Also presented were detailed plans for the Northwestern Ave improvements that are being done this summer and the current 18 month INDOT construction contract letting list. - b. May 29 accident involving distracted driver hitting and injuring a cyclist on the Harrison Bridge and the June 6 Taking the Lane Awareness Ride. Also, follow up happenings related to this.
- c. A 52 year old cyclist was killed on July 7 in Warren County 3 miles west of Covington by a hit-and-run driver who was later identified and arrested.
